Amendment and Re-Statement of Director's Interests

In relation to the subscription to raise up to GBP £0.60 million announced 8 March 2011 and the announcement dated 11 March 2011 confirming total voting rights, Avia (AIM: AVIA), the AIM-listed developer and provider of clinical decision support systems, wishes to clarify the following details.

The total amount of funding raised was GBP £557,720 before expenses, following subscription for 1,115,440 new ordinary shares (the "Subscription Shares") from new and existing investors including certain directors at a price of 50p per share (the "Subscription"). Accordingly, following the issue of the Subscription Shares, the total voting rights in respect of each class of share in issue and admitted to trading on AIM at the date of this announcement (and from 11 March 2011) is as follows:
