**Temporary suspension of shares**

Avia (AIM: AVIA), the AIM-listed developer and provider of clinical decision support systems learnt on the 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2011 that the Company cannot sell its developed product into the NHS 111 market as it has now been stated that the Company does not meet the specification for the service under the new guidelines.

The directors are now reviewing the structure of the Company in order to ensure a companywide focus on achieving short- term sales of deliverable products.

The current outcome to the revised sales forecast shows the company's cash flow over the next two to three months to be compromised showing a short fall over this period, which is payroll related. The revised full year forecast shows the Company achieving a positive cash position. The Company has no borrowings.

In line with London Stock Exchange AIM rules a decision was taken by the directors yesterday to suspend trading in shares while we review how shortfall will be covered.
